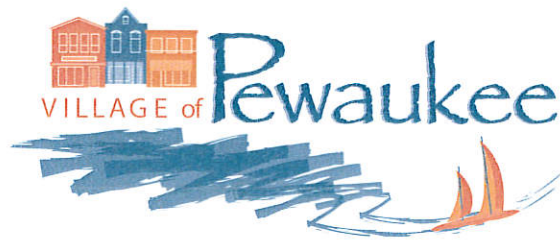

The Village of Pewaukee Police Department is actively recruiting for the position of Police Officer.

The Village of Pewaukee population is about 8000 and located in north central Waukesha County. Pewaukee is home to Pewaukee Lake, Waukesha County Technical College, the Pewaukee School District campus (K-12), various commercial and business complexes, and diverse residential settings.

The Village of Pewaukee Police Department is led by Chief Timothy Heier, and employs nineteen full-time Officers, nine part-time Lake Patrol Officers, and two full-time Support Staff.

Members of the department are encouraged to participate in specialized assignments such as the Suburban Critical Incident Team (SWAT), Major Investigation Unit, and the Waukesha County Metropolitan Drug Enforcement Group, as well as various Departmental specialties.

*Responsibilities:* Preventive and Directed patrol enforcement of Federal, State and Local laws; Obtain, verify and report of information; Respond to emergency and non-emergency calls; Ability to perform the physical functions of a police officer in a community-oriented environment.

*Salary Range:* \$60,795.65 to \$78,624.18, plus educational incentive (2020 Contract).
