

## **Village of Pewaukee Police Commission**

### **Meeting Minutes**

**February 27, 2025**

#### **I. Call to Order/Roll Call**

President Spakowicz called the meeting of the Village of Pewaukee Police Commission to order at 5:05 p.m. on February 27, 2025. President Spakowicz conducted a roll call. The following persons were present: Commissioners William Gehrking, Jodie Borckmann, Jeffery Bublitz and President David Spakowicz. Commissioner Rhode was excused from the meeting. Chief of Police Timothy Heier was also present.

#### **II. Citizen Comments**

There were no citizen present. President Spakowicz asked Chief Heier if the department had received any communication from any citizen that required the attention of the commission, Chief Heier stated no such communication had been received by the department.

#### **III. Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting**

The minutes of the March 6, 2024, meeting were presented for review. Commissioner Gehrking made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Borckmann seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The minutes of the February 7, 2025, meeting were presented for review. Commissioner Borckmann made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Gehrking seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

#### **IV. Closed Session**

President Spakowicz made a motion that the Police Commission move into closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 19.85(1) (c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body had jurisdiction or exercises responsibility – specifically regarding Police Officer candidates. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gehrking.

A roll call vote was taken by President Spakowicz. The vote was unanimous to move into closed session. The commission moved into closed session at 5:17 p.m.

#### **V. Reconvene into Open Session**

Commissioner Gehrking made a motion to reconvene into open session. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bublitz.

President Spakowicz took a roll call vote. The vote was unanimous to move out of closed session. The commission moved into open session at 8:20 p.m.

**VI. Possible Action on Police Officer Candidates**

Commissioner Gehrking made a motion to make a conditional offer of employment to candidate Darryl Thornton pending the successful completion of a background investigation. In addition, the commission recommended that candidate Matthew Paradies be forwarded to the police department for a background investigation. Commissioner Bublitz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**VII. Adjournment**

Commissioner Gehrking made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bublitz. The motion was passed unanimously. President Spakowicz adjourned the meeting at 8:27 p.m.
