

Village of Pewaukee Police Commission

Meeting Minutes

October 6, 2025

I. Call to Order/Roll Call

President Spakowicz called the meeting of the Village of Pewaukee Police Commission to order at 1:03 p.m. on October 6, 2025. Secretary Rohde conducted a roll call. The following persons were present: President Spakowicz and Commissioners Gehrking, Borckmann, Bublitz and Secretary Rohde. Chief Timothy Heier and Deputy Chief Foth was also present.

II. Citizen Comments

There were no citizen comments. Chief Heier had no communications or concerns from the citizens.

III. Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes of the Feb 27, 2025, meeting was presented for review. Commissioner Gehrking made a motion to accept the minutes. Commissioner Bublitz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The minutes of the April 23, 2025, meeting was presented for review. Commissioner Borckmann made a motion to accept the minutes. Commissioner Gehring seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

IV. Closed Session

Commissioner Borckmann made a motion that the Police Commission move into closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 19.85(1) (c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body had jurisdiction or exercises responsibility – specifically regarding Police Officer candidates. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bublitz. A roll call vote was taken by Secretary Rohde. The motion passed unanimously. The commission moved into closed session at 1:06 p.m.

V. Reconvene into Open Session

Commissioner Bublitz made a motion to reconvene into open session. President Spakowicz seconded the motion. Secretary Rohde took a roll call vote and the motion passed unanimously. The Commission reconvened into open session at 4:08 p.m.

VI. Possible Action on Police Sergeant Candidate

Motion was made by Secretary Gehring to recommend Chief Heier to conduct a background check on Officer Dan McKinney and later, the Police Commission will reconvene to discuss the results of the background check. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Borckmann. The Motion passed unanimously.

VII. Possible Action on Police Candidate

No action was taken at this time.

VIII. Adjournment

Commissioner Borchmann made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Bublitz. The motion was passed unanimously. President Spakowicz adjourned the meeting at 4:13 p.m.
