

**Village of Pewaukee Police Commission  
Meeting Minutes  
March 10, 2025**

**I. Call to Order/Roll Call:**

President Spakowicz called the meeting of the Village of Pewaukee Police Commission to order at 5:01 p.m. President Spakowicz conducted a roll call. The following people were present: Commissioner William Gehrking, Commissioner Jodie Borckmann and Commissioner Jeffrey Bublitz. Commissioner Pete Rohde was officially excused from the meeting. Chief Timothy Heier was also present.

**II. Citizen Comments:**

There were no citizen comments. Chief Heier stated the department had not received any communication from the public that needed the attention of the commission.

**III. Closed Session**

Commissioner Borckmann made a motion that the Police Commission move into closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 19.85(1) (c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body had jurisdiction or exercises responsibility – specifically regarding Police Officer candidates. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bublitz.

A roll call vote was taken by President Spakowicz. The vote passed unanimously. The commission moved into closed session at 5:03 p.m.

**IV. Reconvene into Open Session**

Commissioner Gehrking made a motion that the Police Commission move out of closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 19.85(1) (c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body had jurisdiction or exercises responsibility – specifically regarding Police Officer candidates. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Borckmann.

A roll call vote was taken by President Spakowicz. The vote passed unanimously. The commission moved out of closed session at 5:50 p.m.

**V. Possible Action on Police Officer Candidates**

A motion was made by Commissioner Borckmann to place Police Officer candidate Fischer Schneider onto a newly formed eligibility list in order for the police department to officially enroll and sponsor Candidate Schneider at an upcoming Wisconsin Department of Justice Basic Law Enforcement Certification Academy as soon as possible. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bublitz. The motion passed unanimously.

## **VI. Adjournment**

Commission Gehrking made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Borckmann. The motion was passed unanimously. President Spakowicz adjourned the meeting at 5:55 p.m.
