RESOLUTION 2021-18

A RESOLUTION TO REDISTRICT THE WARD BOUNDARIES AND COMBINE MUNICIPAL WARDS FOR VOTING PURPOSES IN THE VILLAGE OF PEWAUKEE, WAUKESHA COUNTY WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes, Section 5.15 requires all cities, villages and towns with a population of 1,000 or more to establish municipal wards based on the results of the 2020 census; and

WHEREAS, Section 59.03(2)(b) of the Statutes requires that each County Board adopt and transmit to each municipal governing body in the county a tentative county supervisory district plan dividing the county into districts and designating the approximate location and population of each ward proposed to effectuate the division of the county into districts; and

WHEREAS, These laws require that each municipality designate by consecutive whole number, geographical description and population, the carious wards to be created within the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Village of Pewaukee, Waukesha County, State of Wisconsin, hereby adopts the wards described as follows (a ward plan map is attached):

Each boundary is described as follows:

Ward 1. The following territory shall constitute the first ward:

That portion of the Village located south of STH 16., east of the westerly Village limits, north of W. Wisconsin Avenue, east of the westerly Village limits that are south of W. Wisconsin Avenue, north of Kopmeier Drive, east of the westerly Village limits south of Kopmeier Drive, north of Pewaukee Lake, west of Isle Court, north of W. Wisconsin, west and south of Quinlan Drive, west of Ryan Road. Excepting therefore a 100 foot wide parcel of land with the southeasterly corner beginning approximately 753 feet northwest of the intersection of Ryan Road and W. Wisconsin Avenue extending northwest 100 feet along W. Wisconsin Avenue.

Ward 2. The following territory shall constitute the second ward:

That portion of the Village located south of STH 16 for approximately 4,329 feet to a tributary of the Pewaukee River, west of the tributary, north of Capitol Drive, east and

north of Park Hill Drive, west of High Street, north of the CP Railroad; east of Isle Court, north of W. Wisconsin Avenue, east and north of Quinlan Drive, east of Ryan Road.

Ward 3. The following territory shall constitute the third ward:

That portion of the Village located north of E. Wisconsin Avenue, west of STH 16, south and west of Hickory Street, south of Oakton Road, west of Elm Street, south of the CP Railroad to a tributary of the Pewaukee River, west of said tributary, south of Capitol Drive, west and south of Park Hill Drive, east of High Street, north of W. Wisconsin, east of Pewaukee Lake, north of the southerly Village limits and northwest of Prospect Avenue.

Ward 4. The following territory shall constitute the fourth ward:

That portion of the Village located north of STH 190 (Capitol Drive), west of STH 164 (Pewaukee Road), west of Swan Road, south of the northerly Village limits off of Swan Road, west and south of STH 164, south of the Village limits, east of a tributary to the Pewaukee River, northeast of Cecelia Drive, west of westerly section of Westfield Way, north of Hillwood Blvd., east of the easterly section of Westfield Way.

Ward 5. The following territory shall constitute the fifth ward:

That portion of the Village located north and east of STH 164 (Pewaukee Road), south of Lindsay Road and west of the easterly Village limits.

Ward 6. The following territory shall constitute the sixth ward:

That portion of the Village located east and south of Evert Street, east of Morris Street, north of the southerly Village limits, east of the Pewaukee River, north of E. Wisconsin Avenue, west of the easterly Village limits, south of Concord Road; south of Meadowbrook Road, west of Willow Grove Road, south and east of Timber Ridge, south of Willow Grove Road, east of Forest Grove Road to the CP Railroad, south of the CP Railroad, east of STH 16, north of E. Wisconsin Ave.

Ward 7. The following territory shall constitute the seventh ward:

That portion of the Village located north of STH 190 (Capitol Drive), east of west section of Westfield Way, south of Hillwood Blvd., south and west of the east section of Westfield Way.

Ward 8. The following territory shall constitute the eighth ward:

That portion of the Village located south of STH 190 (Capitol Drive), west of Forest Grove Drive, north of the CP Railroad to STH 16, north and east of Hickory Street, north of Oakton Road, east of Elm Street, north of the CP Railroad, east of a tributary to the Pewaukee River to the Village limits, east and south of the Village limits, south of Lindsay Road, west of Sussex Street, south of the Village limits, west of a tributary to the Pewaukee River, west and southwest of Cecelia Drive. Also including lands north of Lindsay Road that are within the Village limits.

Ward 9. The following territory shall constitute the nineth ward:

That portion of the Village located southeast of Prospect Avenue, south of E. Wisconsin Avenue, west of Evert Street, west of Morris Street, west of STH 16, north of College Avenue, east of the west and southwest Village limits. Including lands at the southwest corner of Grandview Blvd and College Avenue.

Ward 10. The following territory shall constitute the tenth ward:

That portion of the Village located south of STH 190 (Capitol Drive), west of the easterly Village limits, north of Concord Road, north of Meadowcreek Drive, east of Willow Grove Road, north and west of Timber Ridge, north of Willow Grove, east of Forest Grove Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is accompanied by attached Exhibit A, which is a list of block numbers used by the U.S. bureau of the census that are wholly or partly contained within each ward identified above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is accompanied by attached Exhibit B which is a map illustrating the ward boundaries that are hereby created; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Wards 1-5 created above are hereby combined for voting purposes, so as to share the common polling place of Waukesha County Technical College located at 800 Main Street, Pewaukee, WI and Wards 6-10 at Village Hall, located at 235 Hickory Street, Pewaukee, WI and such combined wards shall use common ballot boxes and ballots, or voting machines and separate returns shall be maintained for the combined wards at any election, except where separate ballots are required under Section 5.58 to 5.64 of the Statutes, and separate ballots or voting machines shall be maintained for any electors of one or more of the combined ward who are in ineligible to vote for any office or referendum for which other electors in the combined wards may vote; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon passage, a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Village Clerk, who shall transmit a copy of the ward plan and this resolution to the County Clerk within five days of its adoption and that this resolution shall remain in effect for each election until modified or rescinded, in accordance with Statute, or until a new division is made following the next federal decennial census.

This Resolution shall be in effect upon approval by the Village Board.
