All dogs over the age of 5 months need to be licensed for 2025 by **March 31st**.

\$15.00 per spayed/neutered dog(s) and \$20.00 per non-spayed/non-neutered dog(s).

Utility Rate Updates

The Village of Pewaukee has initiated a PSC (Public Service Commission) rate case review, which will provide an updated water rate. The cost of operation and maintenance of the Village Water Utility continues to increase. The review will examine the current water rates to determine what increases are necessary to help with the cost of maintaining and providing the Village with sustainable and safe water for the future. The Village is currently in the process of adding a radium filtration system at Well 4 (2025), a temporary PFAS/PFOA filter at Well 6 (2024/2025), and drilling another well (2029).
